A Battle Won

Louisiana College, a Christian college founded in 1906, has won their legal battle against the Obama Administration's HHS mandate which requires religious employers to provide insurance coverage for abortion pills at no cost to employees regardless of religious or moral objections. In response, a federal court issued a decision Wednesday in *Louisiana College v. Sebelius* that the Obama administration's abortion pill mandate violates the school's religious freedom. Keep those lawsuits coming!

Respect Life Sunday

Respect Life Sunday will be October 5th this year. Initiated by the United States Conferences of Catholic Bishops in 1972, it is a wonderful day to celebrate the humanity of the unborn child and pray for an increased awareness and respect for the dignity of the human person. Protect and Serve

In August 2013, at a Michigan correctional facility, Sheriff Kim Cole was asked to allow an inmate to have an abortion at the prison. Pro-life Sheriff Cole refused to sign off on this and said that if "Sarah" wanted an abortion, she would have to get a court order. Weeks went by before he received the sad news that the order had been issued. But a short time later, the sheriff received an unexpected message — Sarah had a change of heart. When she met with Sheriff Cole later, she explained that she was grateful that she had the extra time to think things through. After being connected with a pregnancy counselor, Sarah chose to place her child in an open adoption. Sheriff Cole keeps a photo of himself holding the newborn on his desk. "She made the right choice, and I admire her and love her for that," he said. "She's given him an opportunity to write his own life story."



Baby "Life Facts"

A baby's development in the womb is an amazing process. Most know that a baby's heartbeat begins at 18-21 days, but here are some other interesting facts. At 10 weeks, a baby will respond to touch. If the mom's stomach is poked, the baby will wriggle away. The heart, lungs, kidneys and brains are all fully formed and functional by 10 weeks! A baby has its own unique fingerprints by 13 weeks. A 21 week-old baby is the length and weight of a banana. At 27 weeks, a baby's eyes open and they begin to develop focus. From 33 to 40 weeks, the baby gains one half pound per day. And not surprising to many of us, only 5% of all babies arrive on their due date!

Protecting Women and Children

The Pro-Life Union continues to encourage our elected officials and government agencies to protect women and children from the abortion industry. This industry is filled with unscrupulous practitioners, like Steven Brigham, who, according to a judge, "has suffered license revocations. He has run afoul of licensing authorities in New York, Pennsylvania and Florida." Mr. Brigham's behavior is not a surprise, but it took years of pressure from the pro-life community to bring his crimes to light. Abortion is seen as a "hot-button issue," so many times those in power wish to avoid addressing the violations committed by the abortion industry.

Reports continue to come in showing violations, including sub-standard sanitary conditions and failure to comply with mandatory reporting requirements by abortion companies in our area. In a recent letter sent to all of our local reps and senators, the Pro-Life Union once again asked that existing Pennsylvania laws regulating abortion be strongly enforced.
