Possibly facing another experience similar to the first, Ann giving birth surely took significant grit , hope, fortitude and courage. Hats off to Ann

and all women!

The list of reasons that people abort babies is long. "It will be too hard; I could never do that; we can't afford a child; the baby is diagnosed with Down Syndrome; I have to finish school; or we're not ready." Each one simplified is "Having this baby will be painful." It's true. There's no sugarcoating it. Life hurts. Much courage required.

This week I received a call about a woman who's 1st trimester child was diagnosed with a serious physical defect. This mom had gone to the abortion clinic not once, but twice. Yet she couldn't go through with with taking the life of her child. Thank God! "Could we offer her an emergency room at Guiding Star?" The answer was, "yes we can!" There are so many good stories like this every day around this great region.

#### "Slow Code"

When doctors suspected that Brad and Jesi Smith's unborn daughter had Trisomy 18, they were encouraged to get an amniocentesis to confirm and then abort. The couple refused the amnio so when Faith was born, she did not yet have an official diagnosis. A cardiologist found a large hole in the baby's heart and assured the Smiths that an operation would solve the problem and save the baby's life... until he learned that the Faith had Trisomy 18. He then told her parents, "You may not want to do anything," but he said he would do the surgery if "an Ethics Committee approved." The Smiths soon learned that this common stalling and denial of medical treatment for children with disabilities is called "Slow Code." Faith is now nine years old, loves swimming and horseback riding, and brings joy to her parents and siblings. She and life seem pretty compatible to us!
