Exciting News



Over the last several weeks, the Boards of Directors for the Pro-Life Union and our long-time partner, Guiding Star Ministries, have been working to finalize a formal transition of the Guiding Star organization to the Pro-Life Union. Guiding Star provides housing for expectant mothers and their children, as an alternative to abortion. This program is unique in the Philadelphia region in that it welcomes both pregnant women and their children. We are so proud of our decades-long partnership and grateful for this opportunity to create an even stronger continuum of care for women and families in our city.

The Pro-Life Union regularly encounters abortion-vulnerable women through our sidewalk counseling, prayer vigils, and Pregnancy Hotline. With this change, we are already working to expand Guiding Star in several key ways:

- © Increase the number of women and children served with safe housing annually
- © Create a Family Center where Guiding Star clients in the community can receive baby supplies, gently used clothing, furniture, etc.
- © Expand social services for residents and clients including counseling
- Expand programming for residents and clients including parenting workshops, job training, and mentor support.

How You Can Help

1. Volunteer

We are currently seeking individuals and families to assist as mentors for the women, children, and families we serve. These volunteers will walk with each mother and her children, offering support and guidance throughout their journey.

Sidewalk Counseling Training

The Pro-Life Union will offer our Sidewalk Counseling Training on Sunday, September 13, 2015 at St. Peter Church, 2835 Manor Rd., West Brandywine, PA 19320. There will be two sessions: 3:00 pm – 5:00 pm and 7:00 pm – 9:00 pm. The pro-life community engages in sidewalk counseling in order to reach women as they are entering an abortion facility and provide them with alternatives, information, support and love. In this training, participants will learn effective tools for reaching women in this critical moment. They will also gain an understanding of why women may be considering abortion. Practical tips will be provided. There will be time for questions & answers. Information on the network of resources that are available to women will also be presented. Representatives from two local Crisis Pregnancy Centers, Birthright and Chester County Women's Services, will provide information on the free services they offer at their centers.

The seminar is sponsored by St. Peter's Respect Life Committee and will be conducted by Edel Finnegan, Director of the Pro-Life Union of Greater Philadelphia.

Planned Parenthood Update

The Center for Medical Progress continues to release videos exposing Planned Parenthood's involvement with the sale of fetal tissue. States have begun investigations and some have already defunded the abortion giant. Rallies were held in many cities throughout the U.S. on August 22nd in response to the atrocities which has gotten the attention of the media. The Pro-Life Union was present at Planned Parenthood in Center City and we were grateful to CBS News for their segment on the Rally and the surrounding controversy. The words of the Gospel of St. John come to mind "And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not." A light is shining on the abortion industry and yet they remain undeterred. So, we strengthen our prayers and efforts, confident that the light is penetrating hearts. The upcoming 40 Days for Life Campaign is a great opportunity to get involved. The Power of Prayer

A new friend to the Pro-Life Union shared this lovely and amazing story with us recently and we pray it will give you hope! "A few weeks ago, I joined the group praying at Planned Parenthood. I felt like I was walking into a battlefield. Then I witnessed a young girl "Anne" leaving the clinic and walking down to talk to us. It was a blessing to see how quickly the sidewalk counselor made a phone call to the Hotline and was able to find help. There is another layer to that miracle, I asked "Anne" why she had come so far from her home and she answered that the facility near her wouldn't perform an abortion after 13 weeks, 6 days and she was in her 14th week. A few days later, as I began thinking about the baby our family has "spiritually adopted." I looked at the date of when we began the spiritual adoption... May 7, 2015-14 weeks and one day before I witnessed "Anne" leaving the clinic. I had wondered how my prayers could help a baby, and God answered by letting me know how our prayers for these children are heard and answered."
