# **Inspection Reports**

The most recent inspection reports show once again how the abortion industry disregards the most basic standards of care expected of healthcare providers. This may be because abortion is not healthcare, and it certainly isn't caring for patients. In April of this year, Gov. Wolf (a former Planned Parenthood clinic escort) and the Planned Parenthood chief visited the Warminster Planned Parenthood. Now, months later, a recent inspection report noted violations and found that the facility "failed to conform to all applicable State Laws." The Warminster Planned Parenthood failed to report the fact that a woman's uterus was perforated during an abortion. This is a serious incident requiring notification to the state, but, according to the report, the woman was discharged and then needed care at the emergency room. Violations, failed inspections, wounded women, and lost lives: that is the abortion industry.

#### One in Seven
