Outrageous Senate Vote

On January 29th, U.S. Senate Democrats blocked a vote on a pro-life bill to ban late-term abortions that would save approximately18,000 unborn babies from abortion each year. The bill, entitled the "Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act," would ban abortions after 20 weeks and highlights the intense pain that babies feel during an abortion. A total of forty-eight (48) Republicans and three (3) Democrats voted to put the bill up for debate, but 60 votes were needed. President Trump promised to sign the bill and called upon the Senate at the March For Life to "pass this important law and send it to my desk." We are thankful that our two Senators, Bob Casey and Pat Toomey, voted to protect defenseless unborn innocents.

2018 March For Life

Although the media always underestimates the crowd numbers at the annual March For Life, the rough estimate from pro-life groups is between 400,000 and 500,000 people. The theme this year was "Love Saves Lives" and the crowd was addressed by President Trump via a live video. Other speakers included Paul Ryan, Pam Tebow and former NFL player Matt Birk. Afterward, participants marched to the Supreme Court and then visited politicians to petition them to pass legislation to protect the pre-born. It was an extremely inspiring day and a witness to life. The Philadelphia Archdiocese estimates more than 3,500 from our area attended. Missed it? Mark your calendar for Friday, January 18, 2019.



Goodbye Cecile Richardson

Planned Parenthood CEO Cecile Richardson confirmed in an e-mail to PP donors that she is resigning. Under her administration, PP killed as many as 3.8 million babies. Although the reason for her resignation is unclear, many pro-life leaders believe that it is due to the impending FBI investigation into Planned Parenthood's sale of aborted baby parts that potentially violates both federal and state laws. While no CEO has been able to keep this billion-dollar organization out of scandal and investigations, Richardson has left PP with an all-time low image and brand. 40 Days for Life has grown from one city to 471, 43 PP offices and abortion centers have closed their doors and over 170 PP workers have had a change of heart and left this gruesome business. Three Times the Joy

Beth Morton from Essex, England was shocked to learn that she was pregnant and that her birth control had failed her. More shock came when the doctor revealed that she was pregnant with triplets, which is very rare without the use of IVF. Beth was offered a "selective reduction," in which doctors terminate the life of one or two of the babies. She refused, saying "How could you possibly choose one baby's life over another ... we were determined to give all three of them the best possible chance. I know it was a risky pregnancy, but I trusted the doctors to look after us all." Beth can't imagine her life without each of them.
