March for Life 2017



The streets of DC were filled last Friday with people from all over the country who came to march for life. This annual event is a celebration of the gift of life, and an opportunity to speak with legislators and to the broader community about the sanctity of life. The peaceful, family-friendly event shows the power and positivity of the pro-life movement. Buses from all over the Philadelphia area traveled down to DC and heard amazing speakers. Congresswoman Mia Love delivered an emotional and powerful address, sharing her own story and beliefs. Her words are a reminder to us all: "Each child born and unborn has the potential to open up our world and take us to places and spaces we've never imagined. Each living child carries with him or her the potential for greatness."

Witness in Philadelphia

The Pro-Life Union sponsored a Prayer Rally in Center City at Planned Parenthood on Saturday, January 28th. Pilgrims and friends from the Diocese of Omaha joined us in prayer. Over 250 young people filled the street outside of Planned Parenthood and heard from speakers proclaiming the dignity of the human person. We loved that the students led us in prayer. Many were visibly moved as Sidewalk Counselors reached out to people going to the clinic and when they learned how many babies were aborted.

In late January, Planned Parenthood celebrity supporter Ali Larter, during a visit to Philadelphia, said "This policy has nothing to do with abortion..." The "pro-choice" position has everything to do with abortion, and nothing to do with healthcare, or women's rights. Abortion is not healthcare. It is the destruction of an innocent human life. Planned Parenthood is the famous brand of the abortion industry. According to their own 2014-2015 Annual Report, 323,999 human beings lost their lives at Planned Parenthood facilities. Last Saturday, we stood for the unborn children and for women, and we prayed for healing and conversion.







Gosnell - The Follow-Up

A new book, Gosnell – The Untold Story of America's Most Prolific Serial Killer, was recently released. A book signing took place at the Barnes & Noble in Willow Grove. One of the real heroes of the story was Detective Jim Wood. He acted courageously throughout the difficult case. His commitment to the dignity of every person was evidenced by his behavior and tenacity. The Gosnell story is horrific and Kermit Gosnell is a deeply disturbed man. Revisiting the case serves as a reminder that it is up to the pro-life movement to ensure that the abortion industry complies with regulations. Abortion hardens the heart and dulls the conscience, and it cannot be sanitized. Regulation and oversight do not make abortion right or good, but they do open the public's eye to the reality of abortion

A cursory glance at a recent state report shows ongoing violations at many major abortion companies. The Philadelphia Women's Center report stated that the facility failed to provide written pre-operative instructions to each patient prior to the procedure for 18 of the 18 medical records reviewed. This is a facility doing abortion well into the second trimester. In our Public Affairs efforts at the Pro-Life Union, we remain focused on ensuring that already existing legislation is enforced.
