#### **Understanding Marriage**

Those of us who promote the traditional understanding of marriage as the exclusive, permanent relationship between one man and one woman have been accused of being unfair. But this debate is not about fairness or equality; it is about strengthening marriage and building a culture that helps to sustain marriage. Ryan Anderson has written an outstanding report published by the Heritage Foundation entitled "Marriage: What it is, Why it Matters and the Consequences of Redefining It." We encourage everyone to read the report. "In redefining marriage to include same-sex couples, what you're doing is you're excluding the norm of sexual complementarity. Once you exclude that norm, the three other norms – which are monogamy, sexual exclusivity and permanency – become optional as well." #### Planned Parenthood in Pa.

The Pa. Family Council reminds us of the huge presence of PP in our state. During 2012, this organization committed 16,813 abortions in Pa., which is 64% of all Pa. abortions and a 6% increase from 2011. Here in the Greater Philadelphia area, they committed 11,318 abortions. During 2012, their records indicated receiving \$6.5 million from taxpayers.

#### **Birth Rate**

Look for Jonathan Last's "What to Expect When No One's Expecting: America's Coming Demographic Disaster." To maintain a population, there must be a 2.18% birthrate. Even with help from immigrants, ours is now at 2.0%. The Sexual Revolution that replaced Judeo-Christian values continues to hurt.

## **Harrisburg Update**

Meetings have been held recently with Lt. Gov. Cawley and Jennifer Branstetter, Director of the Governor's Policy Office. Pro-life and family leaders presented them with a number of needs. We are grateful for the positive work done by the Pa. Dept. of Health (DOH) and expect more inspections and penalties, including abortion facility closures. It has become apparent that "informed consent" is not being conducted legally.

We continue to work with groups throughout the State to promote pro-life and pro-family legislation. Obamacare Opt Out is first on our agenda, followed by the defunding of abortion providers, providing an ultrasound image for abortion-minded women, protecting marriage, stopping the cover-up of sexual predators and tightening abortion restrictions. ## The Catholic Church

At the moment, the Roman Catholic Church runs 26% of all healthcare facilities in the world, 117,000 hospitals, clinics and orphanages, 18,000 pharmacies and 512 centers for those who suffer leprosy. In the U.S., they operate 911 hospitals and 418 orphanages. The Church remains a tireless defender of the most vulnerable in society.

### **Stop Federal Funding of PP**

The federal government continues to send tax dollars to this group which abuses so many women, kills so many children, encourages our young to be sexually promiscuous and spreads so much disease. The current White House and U.S. Senate will continue this abomination. On 2-21-13, 71 federal legislators sent a letter to the U.S. Comptroller General asking for the results of the audit of these funds. Did PP spend these funds per federal regulations? Rep. Joe Pitts was the only local signer. Please contact our senators and federal reps. You might also ask why PP is funded, but not the Red Cross or Salvation Army.

## "People are Waking Up"

These were the words of Arkansas State Sen. Rapert after the Arkansas House overrode the Governor's veto of a bill banning abortion after 12 weeks if a heartbeat is detected. PP and the ACLU are heading to federal court. In Alabama, the State Supreme Court ruled that a preborn child is a person. The case involved two mothers who used illegal drugs during their pregnancies. Alabama law states that one may not expose a child to a controlled substance. Opposing attorneys argued that a pre-born child is not covered by law.

The Legacy of Life Foundation continues its unique and successful outreach to women through two centers. The centers are located in Philadelphia and Bucks County.
