Plan of Correction

Another disturbing report about the abortion industry is available for Pennsylvanians. The inspection report for the notorious Philadelphia Women's Center defies the safe and rare mantra. In 2016, there were 5,733 abortions performed at this facility. The inspection report details issues with privacy, safety and sterilization procedures. Once again, the state outlines a "plan of correction," which does little for the women already impacted by the failures and the loss of a child. There is no "plan of correction" for abortion, because the industry takes the life of an unborn child while the state allows the evil to continue. The business of abortion is fundamentally corrupt and ugly and so we are compelled to do what we can to stand against abortion and for women. Please continue participating in outreach activities at these facilities.

This Christmas, the PLU is amazed by the community built at our maternity home Guiding Star. We adopted GSM as a tangible sign of our commitment to life and as service to those who make the choice for life. That service has transformed those of us who have the joy of spending time with the families. We have housed twenty-three women, children, toddlers and new babies.
