#### A Better Way Than Abortion

cross Greater Philadelphia in 2019, more than 18,000 innocent humans died from abortion. On average, there are forty-seven (47) abortions every day, six days a week, within Philadelphia city limits. Imagine a school bus filled with children quietly losing their lives every day. Not clumps of cells, not almost humans; rather fully human rapidly developing innocent lives. No serious embryologist or medical or scientific expert suggests otherwise.

A human being, with unique DNA, begins life at the moment of conception. An independent heartbeat starts by 22 days gestation, and a complete nervous system, digestive tract and functioning limbs are present by eight weeks. The DNA created on day one will dictate the eye color, and the height and the temperament of a unique person who deserves the opportunity to experience the world and contribute to it. The heart that beats on day 22 deserves the chance to beat slowly during a blissful sleep or beat rapidly at an exciting sports event. The arms and limbs that stretch and shift and grab in week eight (8) deserve the freedom to reach for the stars or to embrace another.

Since Roev Wade in 1973, approximately one million (1,000,000) innocent humans have been aborted in Southeastern PA. Imagine the individuals that are not with us due to legalized abortion.

The Pro-Life Union of Greater Philadelphia seeks to help people understand the facts, the sanctity of life, and influence public policy. We also offer real alternatives. There are many services and resources across Greater Philadelphia for expectant parents during each trimester and after birth when life is chosen for their unborn child: Pregnancy Resource Centers, Catholic Social Services, local and state assistance programs, low cost/no cost medical clinics all support pregnant women, children and families. There are homes and housing resources for pregnant women and there are many adoption services for parents who are unable to keep and care for their child. We mourn the loss of life as we recognize the 48th anniversary of Roe v. Wade.

There are alternatives to abortion — that leave the right to life intact, and mothers unharmed, and create a better society. Choose life. Join us on the 23rd the Philadelphia March for Life as we pray, march, and proclaim together — that there is a better way.

# 10 Years Since Gosnell Grand Jury Report

On January 19, 2011, the findings were released of the grand jury that was charged with investigating the activity of the Women's Medical Society in West Philadelphia; operated by Kermit Gosnell. While pro-abortion organizations have claimed that laws regulating abortion facilities hurt women, the Gosnell case prove the opposite to be true: abortion hurts women. As the report stated, "This case is about a doctor who killed babies and endangered women ... it is about disdain for lives and health of women and infants." (Page 1, Grand Jury Report)

The Gosnell case exposed the brutality and degradation that abortion inflicts on women and children in our city, and the awful truth is that this did not stop once Mr. Gosnell was behind bars. The more than 14,500 abortions that occur annually within Philadelphia's city limits are not safe or beneficial for women, they inflict physical and emotional wounds that last for a lifetime. And simultaneously, every single abortion means the death of at least one valuable, unique and unrepeatable human being.

Gosnell eventually stood trial and was convicted of three counts of first-degree murder for the death of three babies that were born alive and killed. He was also convicted of involuntary manslaughter in the death on Karnamaya Mongar.

#### Let the March Begin!


After mass and a short break we will begin our march to Philadelphia Women's Center, where over 6,500 abortions are performed each year.
