The next campaign for 40 Days for Life begins on September 27th and continues until November 5th. Through God's grace and the commitment of many people, stunning results have been achieved through the 40 Days for Life effort. God works through order and simplicity and this unified effort has brought a life-saving message to our communities. Here in Philadelphia, it has been the forerunner to our Sidewalk Servants Program, filling the time with prayer and witness in between campaigns.

Join the campaign and be a part of this great work defending and protecting life. Forty Days for Life has been hosted in 715 Cities with 750,000 volunteers in 44 nations. Nationally, 13,305 lives have been save and at the two locations here in Philadelphia we know of 35 babies who have been born and not aborted. The conversations that we engage in have opened eyes to the sanctity of human life.

The Pro-Life Union is excited to share the great news of continued expansion of our partnership with Catholic Social Services at Guiding Star Ministries. We have worked with CSS at Guiding Star for two years and they have provided Case Management to residents. In July, CSS staff members Yvonne and Diamond joined GSM to provide increased program and case management. These two women and the entire team at CSS have hearts of service, recognizing the dignity and value in every life. Our residents are served well and now we are expanding Community Outreach.

In September, a diaper bank, parenting classes and parenting café's will be held in the Hall of St. Benedict Parish, adjacent to Guiding Star. Our residents will attend classes there and we will extend the invitation to women we meet through our Hotline and Sidewalk Counseling. This community outreach is really exciting.

The material gifts, the classes and support offered are the tangible signs that women and communities vulnerable to abortion need. This outreach is an invitation to a relationship with the pro-life community. In this way, abortion becomes unthinkable and hope begins to build. Lives are saved through this outreach and communities will be transformed!

Guiding Star Update

It is always exciting to welcome new families into the home. It is a time of adjustment and growth for staff and residents. Last week we gathered together to we celebrate one mom's birthday and welcome our expanded partnership with our staff from Catholic Social Services.

In the last eighteen months Guiding Star has responded to over 200 phone calls providing emotional support and guidance, and offering referrals and material assistance to women and families. Fifty-four individuals including pregnant women, toddlers and new babies have been given housing. Our families have participated in life skills classes, community meals and case management support. Your generosity has also allowed the moms and babies to receive clothes, diapers and baby items along with household items like laundry soap and food when needed.

Adoption Facts

We love our friends at Adoption is a Loving Option and Brave Love. Adoption is often misunderstood even by those who hold pro-life beliefs. Myth #1 – Adoption is "giving up" - the term is from the 1800s. The modern term is "Making an adoption plan."

Myth #2 – Birth moms don't care about their child – All birth moms share one common bond – the best life for their child.

Myth #3 – Birthparents can show up at any time to "take back" their child – These stories are extremely rare.

Myth #4 – Open adoption is damaging to the child – It is an ongoing relationship, not a one-time event.

Myth #5 – Adoption doesn't affect me – Most Americans have a personal connection to adoption.

Abington Hospital Board Meeting

Pro-lifers met with the Board of Directors at Abington Hospital in an attempt to change the abortion policy of the hospital. Dr. Louis Welsh reminded the Board that he became a doctor to help people, not to terminate children in the womb. Dr. Monique Ruberu spoke of the pain that mothers deal with years after the abortion takes place. Dr. Chris Christiansen pleaded with the Board to let his Department of Critical Care work with the Ob-Gyn Department to deal with the hard cases.
